# Hot Springs Municipal Airport



The Hot Springs Municipal Airport can accommodate a variety of aircraft, from J3s to Gulfstream corporate jets. Because of its geographical location, the airport serves as a permanent air tanker fire base during the summer fire season. The Hot Springs Municipal Airport also serves our community and VA hospitals with Life Flight Transportation.

Flight training is available from the private pilot to a commercial pilot rating. Or if you are up for a thrill and want to jump out of an airplane, the Hot Springs Sky Dive Club is available to you. Other recreation opportunities include the Black Hills Glider Club.

One of the many unique events held annually at the Airport is the Annual Badlands RV Fly-In, bringing over 60 planes per year to Hot Springs.

Evans Plunge’s water enters the pool at a rate of 5,000 gallons per minute! Because of this fact, our pool completely recycles itself every hour and a half. The pool stays a consistent 87° F year round. While this is not “hot” as other hot springs located around the world, our mineral water does not contain the same harsh minerals usually found in other springs. Our naturally-heated, crystal clear water is perfect for year-round fun for those local to Hot Springs and our guests. With the best water in the world, a health club, and tons of recreation opportunities for all ages, what better place to bring the family for a day of fun?

# Parks and Trails



<b>Brookside Park</b>	A local secret, Brookside is situated off South River Street along the Freedom Trail. With newly installed playground equipment and shoreline access to the Fall River for swimming, Brookside is quite the destination come warmer weather.
<b>Butler Park</b>	Hot Springs' largest park, Butler park features baseball and soccer fields, a skate park, playground, tennis courts, a basketball court, horseshoe pits and two picnic shelters. Located on the south end is the Hot Springs Public Library.
<b>Centennial Park</b>	The unofficial town square, Centennial is home to numerous events throughout the year including the Main Street Arts and Crafts Festival in June. Centennial Park conveniently sits between many historic downtown shops and the Freedom Trail, just down the way from Kidney Springs and the Chamber of Commerce Depot Visitor Center.
<b>Lower Chautauqua</b>	Surrounded by a rock cliff and large sandstone boulders, Lower Chautauqua offers a swingset and picnic area with grill.
<b>Upper Chautauqua</b>	A popular and scenic location for weddings, family reunions, and other gatherings, Upper Chautauqua park offers a large picnic shelter, scenic rock walls, access to the Fall River, and picnic tables and grills.
<b>Freedom Trail</b>	Named in honor of those that served, the Freedom Trail is a multi-use, mile-long, paved trail following the Fall River that connects four different park areas. Be sure to have your camera ready as the trail is filled with shutter-worthy sights including wildlife, a Veteran's themed mural, and other scenery that is sure to catch the eye.
<b>Cold Brook Park</b>	Located just around the corner from Evans Plunge, this quiet park features a playground, beautiful mature trees and plenty of space to picnic.
