

Request for Proposal: Painting of the Hot Springs Police Department

The City of Hot Springs is seeking proposals for professional exterior painting services of the Hot Springs Police Department, located at 201 North River Street. Completion date for the painting should occur on or before October 10, 2015.

Requirements to submit a quote for estimates must consider the following:

- 1. 2 paint colors will be used, one for the building siding and a second for the shake-style shingles and building trim**
- 2. Paint will be provided by the City of Hot Springs with the painter providing the labor and paint application supplies**
- 3. Walls to be painted include all walls accessible from the building's exterior, including the shake shingles visible from the ground level**
- 4. The business awarded the project must be able to provide a 5 year warranty, protecting the city against defect in workmanship including peeling, blistering, chipping and other defects directly related to human error in the painting application.**

Proposals are due by September 4th and must include all fees charged by the company. All responses are encouraged to include a list of references for their painting work.
