## **ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS**

- Bicycling:** Instructor Marco Horton will take participants through basic bicycle maintenance and then RIDE (level EASY—requiring basic fitness). Participants must bring bicycle and helmet.
- Cooking:** “Brunch Bunch” cooking with Instructors Kris Hanson & Kathy Hren---- participants learning basic cooking cleanliness preparing an easy brunch as well as taking home a serving to enjoy! Masks will be provided.
- Photography:** “Discover the Natural World Through Photography” with Instructors Bob & Terry, covering basic photo-taking skills, getting out in nature to take pictures, printing a favorite to keep! Participants must bring phone w/picture-taking option or point and shoot dlsr w/memory card. Masks will be provided.
- Group Pickleball:** With a group of 4 of your choice (a COVID-Happy Activity!), learn/improve/evolve at your specific group level with assistance from Instructor Kathy. You may stick around after activity ends for “open gym” to practice your skills! Equipment will be provided.

### Recreation Policies

No participant will be allowed to participate in a recreation program without **Medical Information & Recreation Program Conduct Policies Section** completed (minors need registration forms completed by a parent/guardian. The registration form provided includes all of this information.

Each participant will be given an opportunity to participate. The Hot Spring Recreation Program is an inclusive recreation/learning program.

The Hot Springs Recreation Program does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion, creed, color, national origin, gender, age, disability, political affiliation or for any other basis prohibited by State or Federal Law.

The Hot Springs Recreation Program is committed to providing an environment that is free from discrimination and harassment.

Only instructors, assistants, and registered participants are allowed at activity location unless specifically permitted by the instructor and acting as a volunteer.

### Emergency Procedures Policy

In the event of a Fire Emergency or a Civil Defense Emergency (the sounding of the community Civil Defense siren), the following procedures will be implemented by the Instructors of the Hot Springs Recreation Program. Every attempt will be made to ensure the safety of participants.

1. Participants at an activity at Evans Plunge Mineral Springs will remain at Evans Plunge Mineral Springs.
2. Participants at an activity at Butler Park will be walked immediately to the Mueller Civic Center.
3. Participants at the Mueller Center will remain at the Mueller Center.

A child will be released to an adult upon the signature of the adult accepting responsibility for the child.
